As you pray, expect the Holy Spirit to lead you deeper. Deeper in intimacy with God. Deeper in sensitivity to His voice. Deeper in alignment with His will. Prayer changes more than circumstances—it transforms the one who prays. As you linger in His presence, the Spirit will shape your heart, strengthen your faith, and guide your steps.

May these hours awaken a fresh hunger for God and renew your walk in the Spirit. Come with an open heart, a listening spirit, and an expectant faith. The Lord is ready to meet you, and He will not leave you the same.

Welcome to this holy moment. Walk in, pray on, and go deeper in the Spirit.

PRAYER GUIDES

Prayer Themes

Prayer Themes help focus our hearts on specific spiritual directions rather than praying randomly. They guide us to pray in unity as one church body, believing God for the same purpose and vision.

Scriptures

The Word of God anchors our prayers. When we pray with Scriptures, we are praying according to God's truth and promises.

Reflection

Reflection helps us pause and listen to God. Instead of only speaking to God, we create space for His Spirit to speak into our hearts, bringing conviction, encouragement, and spiritual clarity.

Reflection Points

These help us go deeper personally. They allow us to examine our lives, our relationship with God, and areas where the Holy Spirit may be calling us to grow, surrender, or trust Him more.

Prayer Pointers

Prayer pointers provide direction so that our prayers become intentional and impactful covering personal needs, leaders, ministries, wider communities and nations.

Prayer Declaration

Declarations are faith-filled statements based on God's promises. When we declare them together, we affirm our trust in God's power, His Word, and His purposes over our lives, our church, over people, and nations.

The goal of our 40 Hours of Prayer is not just to complete hours of prayer, but to experience transformation - personally and as a church. As we seek God together, we believe He will renew our hearts, strengthen our faith, and move powerfully among us.

40-HOUR PRAYER GUIDE: How To Use?

- A. Before your prayer time, quiet your heart, remove distractions, and invite the Holy Spirit to lead you.**
- B. Read the Scripture slowly, meditate on the reflection, and use the prayer pointers as a guide - not a script.**
- C. Stay aligned with the hourly theme, but allow the Holy Spirit to deepen or expand your prayers.**
- D. Close your prayer slot by boldly declaring the Prayer Declaration provided.**

Thank God in faith, believing He has heard and is already at work.

- Individuals:**

- Select your specific hour(s) and commit to being present with God during that time.
- Pray personally and sincerely, allowing space for the Spirit to speak.
- You may journal insights, prayers, or impressions during your hour.
- End by committing the next hour to the next prayer partner.

- **Groups:**

- One person may lead while others agree in prayer, or every member of three in a group may take turns praying each prayer pointer.
- Maintain a spirit of unity - pray in agreement, avoid side conversations, and honour one another's time.
- Close with a thanksgiving prayer before transitioning.

For **cross-congregational groups**, unity is found in our agreement in prayer, not in uniformity of participation.

- Participants may pray one by one, in pairs, or silently, according to their comfort level.

At the end of each prayer segment one person may read the Prayer Declaration as a collective expression of faith and agreement.

- **Purpose:** To create a safe and welcoming space where everyone can engage freely while maintaining spiritual unity.

Hour 1 – Gratitude for Salvation

Scripture: Psalm 103:2

Praise the LORD, my soul, and forget not all his benefits

Reflection:

Our greatest thanksgiving begins with salvation. We remember that we were rescued not by works, but by grace through Christ. Gratitude keeps our hearts humble and joyful before God.

Reflection Points:

- Salvation is a gift, not something we earned
- Gratitude deepens our love for Christ

Prayer Pointers:

- Thank God for the cross and forgiveness
- Praise Him for new life in Christ
- Declare freedom from guilt and shame
- Thank God for calling us out of darkness into His marvellous light
- Praise Jesus for the gift of righteousness in Christ
- Thank God for adoption as sons and daughters
- Rejoice in the assurance of eternal life

Prayer Declaration:

“Lord, we thank You for saving us by Your grace. Our lives belong to You.”

Hour 2 – Thanksgiving for God’s Faithfulness

Slot: 6:00am

Scripture: Lamentations 3:22–23

²² Because of the LORD’s great love we are not consumed, for his compassions never fail.²³ They are new every morning; great is your faithfulness.

Reflection: God’s faithfulness sustains us daily. Even when circumstances change, His mercies remain new every morning.

Reflection Points:

- God has never failed His people
- His faithfulness is our anchor

Prayer Pointers:

- Recall answered prayers
- Thank God for past victories
- Praise Him for daily mercy
- Thank God for sustaining us through difficult seasons
- Recall moments when God made a way where there was none
- Praise Him for faithfulness even when we were unfaithful
- Declare trust in God’s faithfulness for the days ahead

Prayer Declaration:

“Great is Your faithfulness, O Lord, in every season of our lives.”

Hour 3 – Gratitude in All Circumstances

Scripture: 1 Thessalonians 5:18

Give thanks in all circumstances; for this is God's will for you in Christ Jesus.

Reflection: Thanksgiving is an act of faith. We give thanks not because everything is perfect, but because God is sovereign.

Reflection Points:

- Gratitude changes our perspective
- God works all things for good

Prayer Pointers:

- Surrender complaints to God
- Thank Him even in trials
- Trust His purposes
- Ask God for a thankful heart in every situation
- Thank Him for lessons learned through challenges
- Praise God for His sovereignty over every season
- Declare joy that is not dependent on circumstances

Prayer Declaration:

“Lord, we choose gratitude in every situation, trusting You fully.”

Hour 4 – Thanksgiving for God’s Provision

Scripture: Philippians 4:19

And my God will meet all your needs according to the riches of his glory in Christ Jesus.

Reflection: God provides according to His riches in glory. He is our source, not circumstances.

Reflection Points:

- God knows our needs
- Provision flows from His goodness

Prayer Pointers:

- Thank God for daily provision
- Acknowledge Him as our source
- Pray against fear of lack
- Thank God for provision seen and unseen
- Praise Him for wisdom in managing resources
- Declare contentment in every season
- Trust God for future provision without anxiety

Prayer Declaration:

“Our God supplies all our needs according to His riches in Christ.”

Hour 5 – Thanksgiving for God’s Protection

Scripture: Psalm 121:7–8

7 The LORD will keep you from all harm—he will watch over your life; 8 the LORD will watch over your coming and going both now and forevermore.

Reflection: God watches over us continually. His protection covers our coming and going.

Reflection Points:

- God is our keeper
- His protection is constant

Prayer Pointers:

- Thank God for unseen protection
- Pray for families and children
- Declare safety and peace
- Praise Him for covering our homes and workplaces
- Pray for divine protection over our minds and hearts
- Pray for protection over travels and journeys

Prayer Declaration:

“The Lord is our protector; we are secure in Him.”

Hour 6 – Gratitude for God’s Presence

Scripture: Matthew 28:20

and teaching them to obey everything I have commanded you. And surely I am with you always, to the very end of the age.”

Reflection: God’s presence is our greatest assurance. We are never alone in our journey.

Reflection Points:

- God walks with His people
- His presence brings peace

Prayer Pointers:

- Thank God for His nearness
- Invite His presence afresh
- Worship Him wholeheartedly
- Thank God that He never leaves nor forsakes us
- Invite the Holy Spirit to renew our awareness of His presence
- Praise God for strength found in His presence
- Declare confidence because God is with us.

Prayer Declaration:

“Lord, we rejoice in Your abiding presence with us.”

Hour 7 – Thanksgiving for the Word of God

- Thank God for His Word
- Pray for hunger for Scripture
- Declare obedience to the Word
- Thank God for truth that sets us free
- Pray for understanding and revelation of Scripture
- Praise God for promises that never fail
- Declare a lifestyle built on God's Word

Prayer Declaration:

“Your Word, O Lord, lights our path and directs our steps.”

Hour 8 – Gratitude for the Holy Spirit

- Pray for fresh infilling of the Holy Spirit
- Ask for boldness and power to witness
- Declare a Spirit-led life

Prayer Declaration:

“Holy Spirit, we thank You for leading and empowering us.”

Hour 9 – Thanksgiving for the Church

Prayer Pointers:

- Thank God for pastors and leaders
- Pray for unity in the Church
- Bless fellow believers
- Thank God for spiritual family and fellowship
- Pray for strength and protection over church leaders
- Praise God for different gifts within the body
- Declare unity and love among believers

Prayer Declaration:

“Lord, we thank You for placing us in Your Church.”

Hour 10 – Thanksgiving for Future Hope

Scripture: Jeremiah 29:11

I will pursue them with the sword, famine and plague and will make them abhorrent to all the kingdoms of the earth, a curse[a] and an object of horror, of scorn and reproach, among all the nations where I drive them.

Reflection: Our hope is secure in God's promises. He holds our future in His hands.

Reflection Points:

- God's plans are good
- Hope fuels perseverance

Prayer Pointers:

- Thank God for His promises
- Declare hope over the future
- Surrender fears to Him
- Thank God that our future is secure in Him
- Declare faith over uncertainties ahead
- Praise God for open doors and divine direction
- Surrender long-term plans to God's will

Prayer Declaration:

"We thank You, Lord, for a future filled with hope in You."

Hour 11 – Hunger for God

Scripture: Psalm 42:1

As the deer pants for streams of water, so my soul pants for you, my God.

Reflection: Revival begins with a deep hunger for God. When our souls long for Him more than anything else, He responds by renewing our hearts and drawing us closer to His presence.

Reflection Points:

- Spiritual hunger precedes spiritual awakening
- God fills those who earnestly seek Him

Prayer Pointers:

- Ask God to restore spiritual hunger
- Pray against complacency and dryness
- Invite fresh desire for His presence
- Ask God to remove distractions that dull spiritual desire
- Pray for a deep longing for God's presence above all else
- Declare a renewed passion for prayer and worship
- Thank God for His promises to satisfy hungry souls

Prayer Declaration:

“Lord, awaken our souls to hunger and thirst for You alone.”

Hour 12 – Repentance and Brokenness

Scripture: 2 Chronicles 7:14

If my people, who are called by my name, will humble themselves and pray and seek my face and turn from their wicked ways, then I will hear from heaven, and I will forgive their sin and will heal their land.

Reflection: True revival flows from repentance. When God's people humble themselves and turn from sin, heaven responds with healing and restoration.

Reflection Points:

- Humility invites God's mercy
- Repentance prepares the ground for revival

Prayer Pointers:

- Confess personal and corporate sins
- Pray for softened hearts
- Ask God to cleanse His Church
- Ask God for a tender and teachable heart
- Pray for repentance that leads to lasting change
- Confess areas of pride and self-reliance
- Thank God for His mercy and forgiveness

Prayer Declaration:

"We humble ourselves, Lord, and turn from our ways. Heal our land."

Hour 13 – Fresh Fire of the Holy Spirit

Scripture: Acts 2:3–4

3 They saw what seemed to be tongues of fire that separated and came to rest on each of them. 4 All of them were filled with the Holy Spirit and began to speak in other tongues as the Spirit enabled them.

Reflection: Revival is marked by fresh fire from heaven. The Holy Spirit ignites passion, boldness, and power for holy living and witness.

Reflection Points:

- God empowers His people through the Spirit
- Revival produces spiritual boldness

Prayer Pointers:

- Ask for fresh infilling of the Spirit
- Pray for spiritual fire and passion
- Welcome the work of the Holy Spirit
- Pray for renewed passion for holiness
- Ask God to burn away spiritual apathy
- Invite the Spirit to empower daily living
- Declare a fresh anointing for God's work

Prayer Declaration:

“Holy Spirit, ignite fresh fire within us for Your glory.”

Hour 14 – Renewed Love for God

Scripture: Revelation 2:4–5

4 Yet I hold this against you: You have forsaken the love you had at first.

5 Consider how far you have fallen! Repent and do the things you did at first. If you do not repent, I will come to you and remove your lampstand from its place.

Reflection: Revival restores our first love for God. When love grows cold, revival calls us back to wholehearted devotion.

Reflection Points:

- Love for God must be guarded
- Returning to first love brings renewal

Prayer Pointers:

- Ask God to renew our love and devotion
- Repent of distractions and idols
- Commit afresh to loving God fully
- Ask God to re-align our priorities toward Him
- Pray for freedom from divided devotion
- Declare wholehearted obedience to God
- Thank God for His unfailing love

Prayer Declaration:

“Lord, restore our first love and wholehearted devotion to You.”

Hour 15 – Conviction of Sin

Scripture: John 16:8

When he comes, he will prove the world to be in the wrong about sin and righteousness and judgment.

Reflection: Revival comes with conviction, not condemnation. The Holy Spirit lovingly exposes sin to bring transformation and freedom.

Reflection Points:

- Conviction leads to repentance
- God corrects those He loves

Prayer Pointers:

- Invite the Spirit's conviction
- Pray for purity and holiness
- Ask for God's grace to obey
- Ask God to reveal hidden sins and attitudes
- Ask God for grace to turn away from sinful habits
- Declare freedom through repentance
- Thank God for His loving correction

Prayer Declaration:

“Search us, O God, and lead us in the way everlasting.”

Hour 16 – Revival in the Home

Scripture: Joshua 24:15

But if serving the LORD seems undesirable to you, then choose for yourselves this day whom you will serve, whether the gods your ancestors served beyond the Euphrates, or the gods of the Amorites, in whose land you are living. But as for me and my household, we will serve the LORD.”

Reflection: Revival must begin in our homes. When families honor God, spiritual life flows to the next generation.

Reflection Points:

- God desires godly households
- Revival strengthens families

Prayer Pointers:

- Pray for salvation of families
- Declare godly leadership in homes
- Pray for unity and love
- Pray for restoration of in broken families
- Ask God to establish prayer and worship in homes
- Declare peace and order in households
- Thank God for generational blessings

Prayer Declaration:

“As for our households, we will serve the Lord.”

Hour 17 – Revival Among the Youth and Children

Thursday, 19 November ‘26

Slot: 9:00pm

Slot: 9:30pm

Scripture: Joel 2:28

And afterward, I will pour out my Spirit on all people. Your sons and daughters will prophesy, your old men will dream dreams, your young men will see visions.

Reflection: God promises to pour out His Spirit on all generations. Revival among the youth secures the future of the Church.

Reflection Points:

- Young people are vital to revival
- God uses every generation

Prayer Pointers:

- Pray for spiritual awakening in youth
- Ask God to raise godly leaders
- Pray for protection from worldly influence
- Pray for a hunger for God among the young
- Ask God to raise spiritual mentors and role models
- Declare protection over young minds and hearts
- Thank God for the next generation of leaders

Prayer Declaration:

“Lord, pour out Your Spirit on our children and youth.”

Hour 18 – Boldness to Witness

Scripture: Acts 4:31

After they prayed, the place where they were meeting was shaken. And they were all filled with the Holy Spirit and spoke the word of God boldly.

Reflection: Revival produces bold witnesses. When God moves, His people proclaim the gospel with courage and authority.

Reflection Points:

- Revival fuels evangelism
- Boldness flows from God's power

Prayer Pointers:

- Ask for courage to share the gospel
- Pray against fear and timidity
- Declare openness to divine appointments
- Pray for compassion for the lost
- Ask God for wisdom in sharing the gospel
- Declare clarity and confidence in testimony
- Thank God for opportunities to witness

Prayer Declaration:

“Lord, fill us with boldness to proclaim Your Word.”

Hour 19 – Signs, Wonders, and Healings

Scripture: Mark 16:17–18

17 And these signs will accompany those who believe: In my name they will drive out demons; they will speak in new tongues; 18 they will pick up snakes with their hands; and when they drink deadly poison, it will not hurt them at all; they will place their hands on sick people, and they will get well."

Reflection: Revival is accompanied by God's power at work. Signs and wonders testify that Jesus is alive and active today.

Reflection Points:

- God still heals and delivers
- Miracles point people to Christ

Prayer Pointers:

- Pray for healing and deliverance
- Ask God to confirm His Word
- Declare faith for the miraculous
- Pray for faith to believe God's power
- Ask God to heal emotional and physical wounds
- Declare freedom from oppression and bondage
- Thank God for victories through Christ

Prayer Declaration:

"In the name of Jesus, we believe for signs and wonders."

Hour 20 – Sustaining Revival

Scripture: Habakkuk 3:2

LORD, I have heard of your fame; I stand in awe of your deeds, LORD.

Repeat them in our day, in our time make them known; in wrath remember mercy.

Reflection: Revival must be sustained through obedience, prayer, and holiness. We ask God not only to send revival but to keep us faithful.

Reflection Points:

- Revival requires stewardship
- Faithfulness sustains God's move

Prayer Pointers:

- Pray God for lasting transformation
- Ask God to keep hearts humble
- Commit to ongoing prayer
- Pray for consistent obedience to God's Word
- Ask God to guard hearts against pride
- Declare perseverance in faith and prayer
- Thank God for ongoing renewal

Prayer Declaration:

"Lord, revive Your work in our time and sustain it among us."

Hour 21 – God’s Heart for All Nations

Slot: 1:00am

Slot: 1:30am

Scripture: Matthew 28:19

Therefore go and make disciples of all nations, baptizing them in the name of the Father and of the Son and of the Holy Spirit.

Reflection: God’s redemptive plan includes every nation, tribe, and tongue. The Great Commission reminds us that the gospel is meant for the whole world, not just for one people.

Reflection Points:

- God desires all nations to know Him
- The Church is called to go and send

Prayer Pointers:

- Thank God for His global mission
- Pray for open hearts among nations
- Commit ourselves to God’s purpose
- Thank God that His love knows no borders
- Pray for renewed missionary vision in the Church
- Ask God to stir hearts to go, give, and pray
- Declare the fulfilment of the Great Commission

Prayer Declaration:

“Lord, we declare that all nations will know and worship You.”

Hour 22 – Salvation of the Nations

Scripture: Psalm 67:2

So that your ways may be known on earth, your salvation among all nations.

Reflection: God's salvation is meant to be known among all peoples. When nations encounter His saving power, they experience true hope and transformation.

Reflection Points:

- Salvation brings light to nations
- God's mercy reaches every people group

Prayer Pointers:

- Pray for mass salvations worldwide
- Intercede for unreached peoples
- Ask God to open doors for the gospel
- Pray for God's conviction of sin and revelation of Christ
- Ask God to draw hearts through dreams and visions
- Declare salvation breaking spiritual blindness
- Thank God for testimonies of transformation

Prayer Declaration:

"Let Your saving power, O Lord, be known among all nations."

Hour 23 – Peace Among Nations

Slot: 3:00am

Scripture: Isaiah 2:4

He will judge between the nations and will settle disputes for many peoples. They will beat their swords into ploughshares and their spears into pruning hooks. Nation will not take up sword against nation, nor will they train for war anymore.

Reflection: God is the Prince of Peace. In a world divided by conflict and violence, we intercede for God's peace to reign among nations.

Reflection Points:

- God desires peace, not destruction
- True peace comes from God

Prayer Pointers:

- Pray for nations in conflict
- Ask God to silence violence and war
- Declare peace in Jesus' name
- Pray for reconciliation between divided nations
- Ask God to comfort victims of war and violence
- Declare God's peace to rule over fear and hatred
- Thank God for His promise of lasting peace

Prayer Declaration:

"We proclaim the peace of God over the nations of the world."

Hour 24 – Righteous Leaders in Government

Scripture: Proverbs 29:2

When the righteous thrive, the people rejoice; when the wicked rule, the people groan.

Reflection: Leadership shapes nations. When righteous leaders govern with wisdom and integrity, people rejoice and nations flourish.

Reflection Points:

- God appoints leaders
- Righteous leadership blesses people

Prayer Pointers:

- Pray for godly wisdom among leaders
- Intercede against corruption
- Ask God to raise righteous leaders
- Pray for leaders to fear God and seek wisdom
- Ask God to expose injustice and corruption
- Declare integrity and accountability in leadership
- Thank God for leaders who honor righteousness

Prayer Declaration:

“Lord, raise leaders who rule with righteousness and justice.”

Hour 25 – Nations in Crisis and Disaster

Scripture: Psalm 46:1

God is our refuge and strength, an ever-present help in trouble.

Reflection: God is a refuge in times of trouble. We intercede for nations facing disasters, poverty, famine, and displacement.

Reflection Points:

- God is near to the suffering
- The Church is called to compassion

Prayer Pointers:

- Pray for comfort for the afflicted
- Ask God for relief and restoration
- Pray for humanitarian workers
- Pray for supernatural provision in affected areas
- Ask God to strengthen relief and rescue efforts
- Declare hope in the midst of devastation
- Thank God for His compassion and mercy

Prayer Declaration:

“Lord, be a refuge and strength to nations in distress.”

Hour 26 – Persecuted Church Around the World

Slot: 6:00am

Slot: 6:30am

Scripture: Hebrews 13:3

Continue to remember those in prison as if you were together with them in prison, and those who are mistreated as if you yourselves were suffering.

Reflection: Many believers suffer for their faith. We stand with the persecuted Church, praying for strength, protection, and perseverance.

Reflection Points:

- The global Church is one body
- God honors faithfulness under trial

Prayer Pointers:

- Pray for courage and endurance
- Ask God to protect persecuted believers
- Pray for persecutors to encounter Christ
- Pray for supernatural peace for suffering believers
- Ask God to strengthen underground churches
- Declare bold faith in the face of opposition
- Thank God for the testimony of faithful saints

Prayer Declaration:

“Lord, strengthen and uphold Your persecuted Church.”

Hour 27 – Missionaries and Gospel Workers

Scripture: Romans 10:15

And how can anyone preach unless they are sent? As it is written: "How beautiful are the feet of those who bring good news!"

Reflection: God sends messengers to carry the good news.
Missionaries are God's instruments to reach the nations with His love.

Reflection Points:
